Fund Raisers

We held our 3rd annual yard sale the 7th and 8th of May. This sale has become one of the primary sources of income for the funding of our Scholarship program.

Three years ago when we were searching for a better source of money it was suggested by Maureen Carl that a yard sale might be the answer and she and Peggylee organized the 1st annual one.

Within hours after the start of the sale it became obvious who the leader was and so Janice Cogswell Radmer became the go-to gal for our yard sales.

We have been very fortunate the last two years and have managed to fund the Scholarship program with the proceeds of the yard sales.

However we still depend on the membership fees and donations to fund some of the other support given to the students. We have, for the last two years, helped subsidize the publication of the Student Yearbook by buying advertising in the Yearbook and also the athletic programs by paying for a sign that is displayed at games in the gym or field.

This year, thanks to all who donated items for sale and those that worked so hard to sell them, we raised \$2280.10 for the Scholarship program.

By Saturday afternoon the majority of the items were gone and the remaining items were offered to Care and Share, a local thrift shop. The items not given to the thrift shop were returned to storage for the next yard sale in August.
