Passed away April 14, 2008 in Spokane, WA after a long, courageous bout with cancer. He is survived by six brothers, numerous nieces and nephews, thousands of friends around the world, and his loving friend and companion Pamela Petersen. He was born August 8, 1931 at the Grub homestead south of Medical Lake, WA. He graduated from Medical Lake High School (class of 1949), then attended Eastern Washington College of Education in Cheney, WA, where he graduated with highest honors. He then served two years in the U.S. Army, returning to teach high school for several years at Twisp and Mead. He then received a Scottish Rite Scholarship to attend George Washington University in Washington, D.C., where he obtained his Master's Degree. He then returned and taught business for one year at Eastern Washington University. He then received another Scottish Rite Scholarship to return to George Washington University, where he received a Doctorate in international business. He was hired by George Washington University, where he was the head of the International Business Department. During this time he traveled to over 116 countries for the University and the U.S. government. When he retired in 1992, he returned to Spokane and had a home built, where he resided. A celebration of life will be held April 23, 2008, 2:00 P.M.
